## Thu, September 18 GIANT'S CAUSEWAY

Then, continue on to see the beautiful Dark Hedges, a breathtaking line of beech trees planted in the 18th century. This location was also featured on the television show, Game of Thrones. Return to your hotel in Belfast in time to meet your group in the hotel restaurant for a delicious meal.

Continue your travel through the Irish countryside into Dublin, check into your hotel and spend some time at leisure before a festive evening with your group. Tonight, enjoy a dinner of Irish specialties followed by a lively show of traditional Irish music, songs and displays of step-dancing.

Stop to visit Trinity College to see the Book of Kells, an 8th century illuminated manuscript of the gospels and the Old Library. Then, continue on to tour Guinness Storehouse to see exhibits on how this world-famous stout was first created and why it is so popular today. Finish your visit in the roof-top bar, where you can sample a draft of Guinness. Head back to your hotel for a free evening.

The entire mountain region is frequented, especially on weekends, by Dubliners, for its scenery and outdoor recreation. Return to your hotel in Dublin, where you might like to freshen up before heading to a local venue to enjoy a wonderful farewell dinner with your fellow travelers.
